**Introduction to Winter OPS** is for students have their first Winter training experience. It covers an introduction to cold weather operations, clothing, equipment safety, first aid, basic survival, search techniques, and woodsman ship. This is not a prerequisite course. This is designed for students that have had no experience in cold weather operations.

The **Basic Course** is a first year course where students can learn about navigation, winter search and rescue techniques, cold weather survival, mission scenarios, patient evacuation, camp site selection, and preparing for cold weather operations.

The **Advanced Course** is a second year course where students will continue their education and skills to properly function in a cold weather environment. You must complete the Basic Course to attend.

The **Special Advanced Course** is designed for cadets and seniors who have previously attended the Advance Winter School. The course will include field mobility, advance search, winter survival, natural shelters, and team leader skills.

The course fee is \$10.00, which must be paid upon check in.
